Primary duties include jobsite safety, scheduling the workforce, coordination of all subcontractors and owner contractors, quality control, material procurement, preparation of timecards and daily reports.

The ideal candidate will be ICC-Certified and hold current certifications in petroleum specific industry products.

Additionally, the successful candidate must demonstrate the following skills and expertise:

- Exhibit a clear understanding of how to control the outcome of an assigned construction project through the use of a variety of technical & interpersonal skills and managing field personnel.
- Demonstrate highly organized behavior and effectively utilize this skill set to manage work.
- Able to perform surveillance quality control inspection on multiple crews and subcontractors.
- Demonstrated experience scheduling and coordinating subcontractors.
- Demonstrated experience in material procurement, including scheduling and coordinating deliveries to the job site.
- Demonstrated experience implementing comprehensive quality control programs for a variety of construction tasks.
- Demonstrated experience enforcing safety codes and regulations.
